 - Chapter 1: What is Iman? (3 Exam Questions)
 - Review the Pillars of Islam.
 - Identify and memorize the Arkanul-Iman.
 - Define and understand the meaning of Iman.
 - Know that Iman means faith, or believing in something, even if you don't see it.
 - Chapter 2: I Believe In Allah (5 Exam Questions)
 - Identify the first pillar of Iman.
 - Understand who is Allah, the Most Glorified.
 - Know that Allah (swt) created the Jinn and Mankind to worship him.
 - Understand that it is wrong to worship anything other than Allah because Allah is the only one who created us and everything that we have.
 - Chapter 3: Allah's Angels (5 Exam Questions)
 - Define who the angels are and what they are made of.
 - Know that the Arabic word for angels is Malaaiakah
 - Identify some of the jobs the angels perform.
 - Know that Allah gives each of us two angels at our sides that record all our actions, both good and bad.
 - Name some of the angels and their duties.
 - Know that Angel Jibreel is the leader of the angels.
 - Understand the duties we have toward the angels.
 - Chapter 4: The Books Of Allah (4 Exam Questions)
 - List all the books of Allah sent to humankind.
 - Know some of the books other than the Quran that Allah sent to the people
 - Recognize that no one can reproduce even one ayah comparable to those of Al-Qur'an.
 - Identify the reasons Allah sent these books to humankind.
 - Know that Allah sent books to the people so that he can teach us how to have a good and peaceful life on earth.
 - Chapter 5: Prophets and Messengers (4 Exam Questions)
 - Explain why Allah sent prophets to humankind.
 - Know that all the prophets came with the same message: Tawheed.
 - Know the meaning of tawheed, the message that was brought by all prophets.
 - Recall how many prophets' names are mentioned in Al-Qur'an.
 - Be able to name 5 Prophets that were mentioned in the Quran.
 - Describe the differences between a prophet and a messenger.
 - Chapter 6: Yawm-ul-Qiyamah: The Day of Judgment (3 Exam Questions)
 - Explain what is Yawm-ul-Qiyamah.
 - Understand when Yawm-ul-Qiyamah will take place.
 - Describe some of the main events that will take place on Yawm-ul-Qiyamah.
