 - Learn what are Ramadan and Siyam.
 - Know that Ramadan is the 9th month of the Islamic Calendar.
 - Understand the special virtues of the month of Ramadan.
 - Know what is unique about the night of Laylat-ul-Qadr.
 - Know that praying the night of Laylat-ul-Qadr is similar in reward to a servant who worships Allah for how many months?
 - Know the importance and benefits of fasting.
 - Know that there is a special gate into Paradise called Ar-Rayyaan for those who fast.
 - Learn the meaning of the hadeeth about Ramadan and the verse from the Qur'an on the topic of fasting in this chapter.
 - Understand the meaning of the hadeeth: "The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him stated, "Whosoever fasts during the month of Ramadan with faith and hopeful of reward, all his past sins will be forgiven."
 - Understand that Sawm shields the Muslim from the Punishment in Jahannam. The Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, has been reported to have stated that The fast and the Qur'an are two intercessors for the servant of Allah on the Day of Resurrection.
 - Know the meaning of Sawm, Siyam and Taqwa.
 - Chapter 2: Ahkam-us-Siyam: The Rules of Fasting (12 Exam Questions)
 - Learn and memorize the twelve months of the Islamic lunar year.
 - Be able to list at least 4 consecutive months of the Islamic calendar.
 - Understand how Ramadan starts and ends.
 - Learn about the recommended sunan or practices of fasting.
 - Understand the Hijri calendar.
 - Know who was the first to establish the usage of the Hijri calendar.
 - Know the following vocabulary terms in terms of fasting: Fard, Wajib, Sunnah, Mustahabb, Haram
 - Be able to cite some examples of when fasting is wajib upon a person.
 - Learn about the recommended days to fast outside of Ramadan.

 - Learn the main nullifiers of fasting.
 - Learn some common actions that do not nullify the fast.

 - Learn about those who are exempt from fasting.
