  - Chapter 1: Prophets of Islam (8 Exam Questions)
    - Describe the main message of all the prophets.
    - Describe the characteristics of the prophets.
      - Be able to cite 2 examples of great Muslim women from Islamic history.
    - Describe the miracles that the prophets brought with them.
      - Be able to cite 3 Prophets and the miracle that Allah provided them.
    - Describe how we should respect our Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him.
  - Chapter 2: Prophets and Messengers (5 Exam Questions)
    - Define the difference between the prophets and messengers.
    - Know the names of the divine books revealed to the messengers.
    - Know which books were revealed to which messengers.
      - Know that Prophets Ibraheem, Dawood, Musa, Isa, and Muhammad were the messengers who received books as part of their revelation.
  - Chapter 3: The First Messenger: The Story of Prophet Nuh (4 Exam Questions)
    - Know that Nuh, peace and blessings be upon him, was the first messenger of Allah.
    - Describe how Allah punished the disbelievers.
      - Learn the lesson from Prophet Nuh's son, about the importance of obeying one's parents and its importance in Islam.
    - Understand the hadeeth of the Prophet where he states that anyone who has in his heart so much as the weight of a seed of arrogance will not enter Paradise.
