 - List some of the things that the Prophet did during Ramadan.
 - Know that Iftar is special because Allah, the Most Majestic, answers your prayers during this time.
 - Learn about the recommendation given to us from the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him, that when eating, fill a third of your stomach with food, another with water, and leave the last third empty.
 - Chapter 4: Mubtilat-us-Siyam: Things that break the fast (3 Exam Questions)
 - List the things that can break the fast.
 - List those who are excused from fasting.
 - Chapter 5: Salat-ul-Taraweeh (3 Exam Questions)
 - Describe the benefits of Salat-ut-Taraweeh.
 - Learn the hadeeth the relates the reward for praying at night during Ramadan.
 - Know that the Prophet, peace and blessings be upon him said, Whoever prays during the nights of Ramadan (only taraweeh) with firm belief and hoping for a reward, all of his previous sins will be forgiven.
